• We have also purchased some wipeable tablecloths for the school & they have proved to be very useful.


Most of the funds raised this year will be going towards a climbing frame for the rectory garden but if you have any other ideas that you think the children would benefit from please let us know.

P's Recipe **Pancakes**

100g/4oz flour

Pinch of salt

1 egg

300ml (½ pint) fresh milk

Melted butter or oil for frying

Topping ideas

Lemon juice & caster sugar Golden or maple syrup Chocolate sauce etc

Pancakes – makes 8 – prep 5min – cooking 20min

- 1. Sift flour & salt into a bowl. Break in egg.
- 2. Gradually add half the milk, beating to form a smooth batter.
- 3. Pour in the remaining milk & beat until quite smooth.
- **4.** Lightly brush base of a small frying pan with melted butter. Stand over a medium heat.
- 5. When pan & butter are hot, pour in 3 tbsp of batter tilting pan to cover base.
- **6.** Cook until pancake moves freely, turn, cook until golden.
- **7.** Repeat with remaining batter.
- 8. Add your favourite topping & enjoy!

Mrs H's Cheat - Skip steps 1-3 & buy a packet of batter mix, add an egg & water & continue with steps 4-8!
